## VILLAGE LEARNING CENTRES (VLC)

**PROJECT:** Village Learning Centres  
**LOCATION:** Gulu, Northern Uganda  
**NUMBER OF EDUCATORS:** 10

The Roots to Fruits Christian Curriculum has been developed for children in kindergarten through to P2 (Grade 2). It is currently being piloted in a number of schools around Uganda, including 5 of the Watoto schools and by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).

The goal is to get this curriculum into remote areas of Northern Uganda and South Sudan and the Village Learning Centres are the delivery method for this empowering curriculum. These multi-grade classrooms will be built in remote areas where there are no or limited educational opportunities.



VLC's and housing for an educator are to be built in partnership with the community using local materials. This community partnership extends to food and meals will be provided by the community for the students and educator.

Educators are trained at the Educator Development Institute through an intensive course focusing on education and sharing the Gospel message with students. Upon successfully completing the course, they are sent out to these remote villages to establish a VLC.



Sponsorship enables the educators to operate their VLC while providing for themselves and their families.

Cost to sponsor an educator:  
-Quarter Sponsorship: \$57 per month  
-Half Sponsorship: \$113 per month  
-Full Sponsorship: \$225 per month
