



GOOD SAMARITAN PRIMARY SCHOOL KAMULI, UGANDA

LOCATION: Kamuli is a small village, in a remote part of South Eastern Rakai District of Uganda (close to the Tanzania border).

PROJECT: In 2006 Pastor Joseph Tumwebaze planted a church in Kamuli. The Good Samaritan Community Primary and Nursery School is an outgrowth of the church.

Current projects underway and funding required:

- New 5 classroom block to replace the existing temporary shelter that as the school for 235 nursery to P1 students.
 - Cost to complete the project: \$65,000
 - \$13,000 per classroom
- Water Tanks to be attached to the Nursery and Primary school blocks to collect water for drinking purpose.
 - Cost: \$3,500 per tank x 4 = \$14,000



- Cost to complete the project: \$3,000
- **Breakfast program** for 235 Nursery/Primary school students.
 - · Cost: 40 cents per day per child
 - \$6.40 per week per child
 - \$77.00 per year per child
- Child sponsorship 100 children are registered and are in need of sponsorship. (300 are on a waiting list for registration and funding)
 - Cost: \$40 per month per child
